EVALUATION METHODOLOGY AND ASSESSMENT PARAMETERS

Marks would be Awarded for two broad criteria i.e. 1. Content and 2. Presentation

1. Content:

- A. Relevance: Candidate should address core demand of the question
 - (a) Candidate should address all sub parts of the questions.
 - (b) Due focus should be given to tail-words like discuss, examine, elaborate, critical analyse etc.
- **B.** *Economy of words:* Candidate should be clear, concise and crisp.
- C. Facts/Examples: Answer should be supported by relevant examples & facts.

2. Presentation:

- **A**. *Language:* Candidate should give due attention to the vocabulary of the subject/topic. It should be simple and direct.
- **B.** *Structure:* Answer should be properly structured. It should include Introduction, Context & Conclusion wherever required apart from the Main Body.
- C. *Orderly*: Points should be arranged in an orderly manner.
- **D**. *Novelty*: Use of unique format like flow chart, diagram etc. if can be added.
